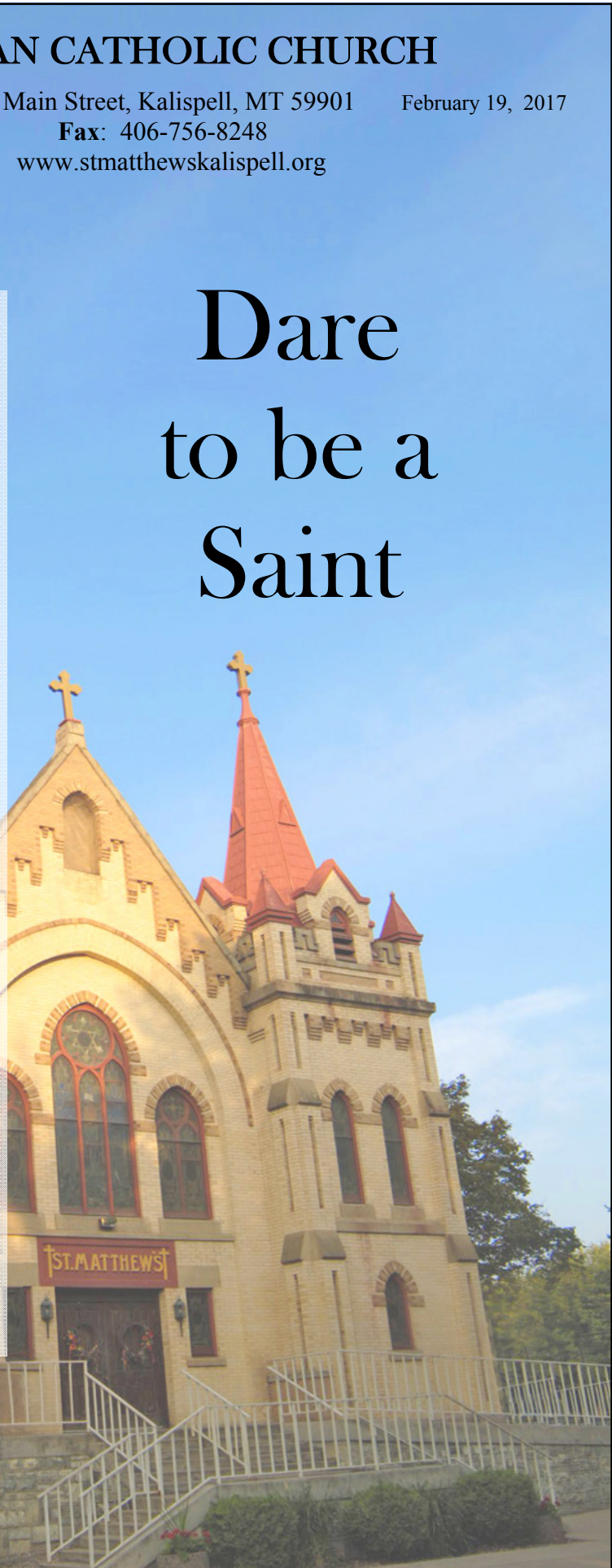

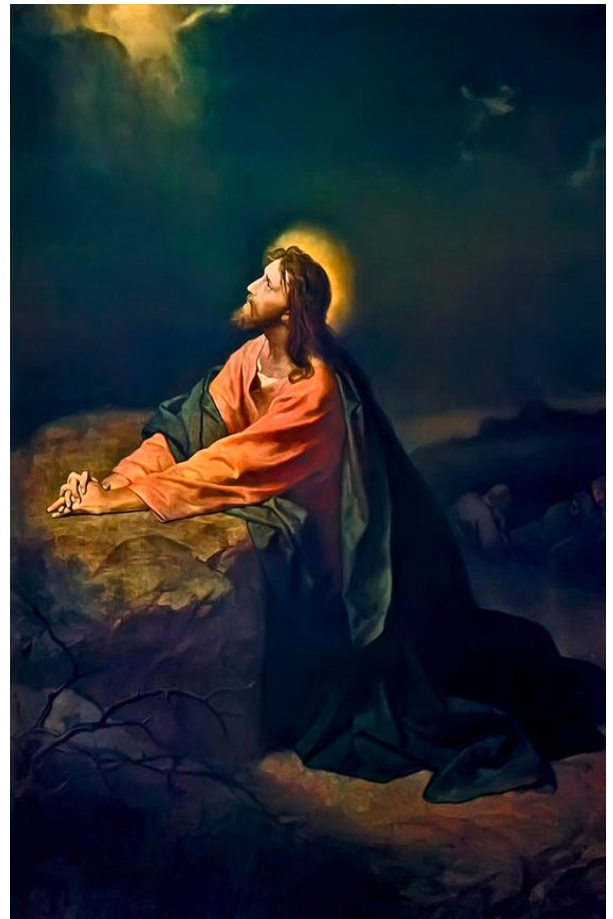


Michael Barber is the Professor of Theology, Scripture and Catholic Thought at John Paul the Great Catholic University.
