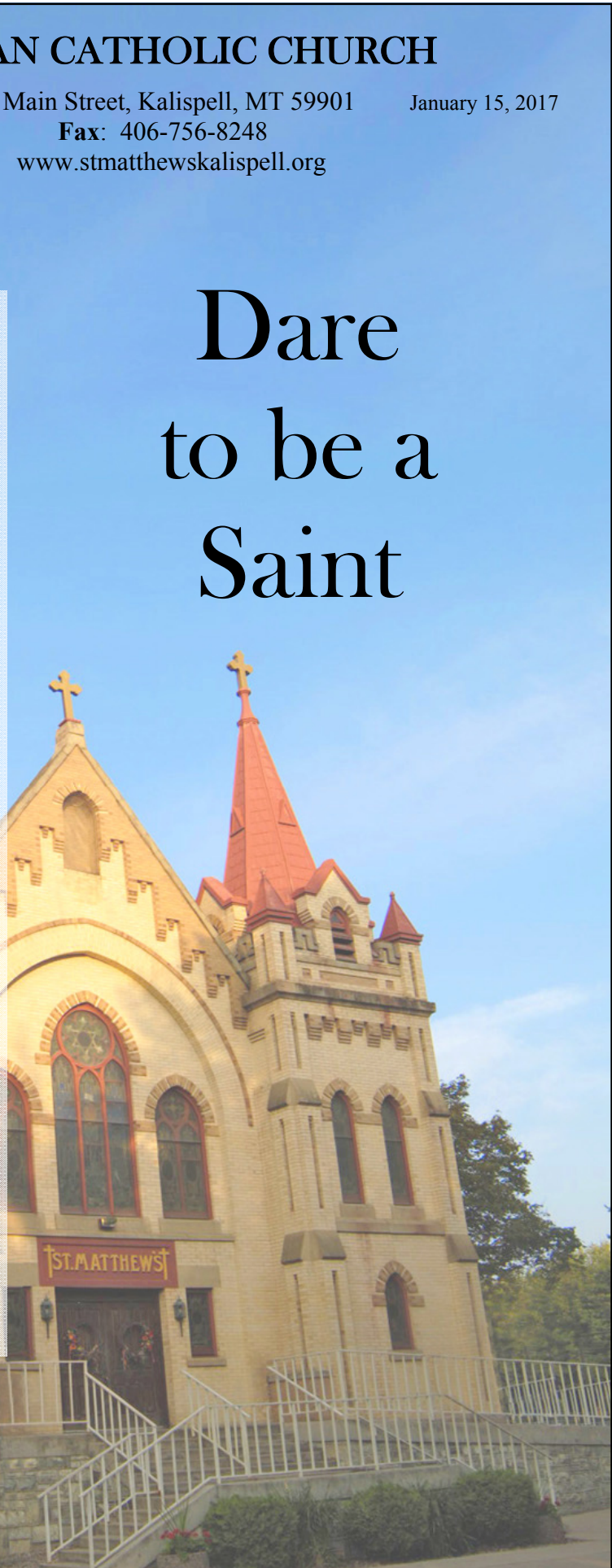

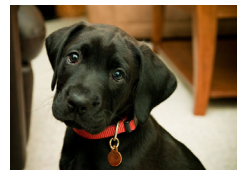

ADORATION

Christ gives Himself to each one of us personally. Not all reality or the created realities of this world are perceived by the senses, which are a source of knowledge but at the same time set a limit to our intellect. The church in her pilgrimage through this world towards the Father possesses in the Holy Eucharist the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, who cannot be perceived by the senses and who has been assumed by the Sacred Humanity of Christ. The Word became flesh in order to dwell among us and to make us partakers of his divinity. He came for the whole world and He would have taken flesh for a single individual, for the least and the most unworthy of men. Saint Paul had a joyful foretaste of this reality, The Son of God, he said, loved me and gave himself for me. Jesus would have come into the world and would have suffered all He did suffer for me alone. Each one of us should think to himself: this is the great reality that fills my life. In the economy of the redemption, the Eucharist was the providential means chosen by God to enable him to remain with us personally, in a unique and unrepeatable way, within each one of us.

Thank God for giving us His Son by giving ourselves and our time, by committing to an hour of Adoration.

CARROLL COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

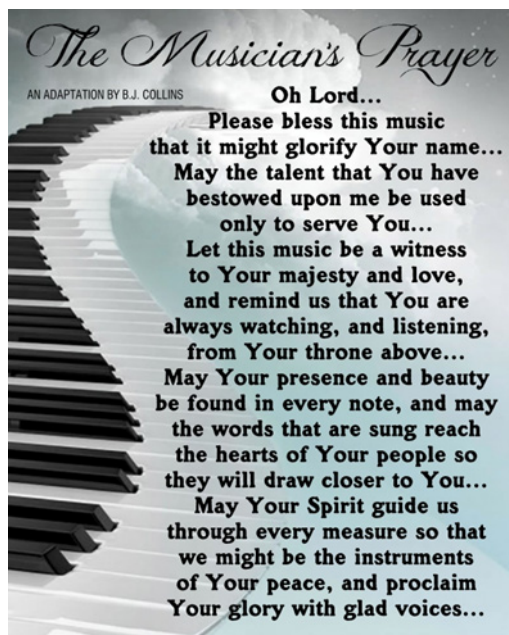
