Christ gives Himself to each one of us personally. Not all reality or the created realities of this world are perceived by the senses, which are a source of knowledge but at the same time set a limit to our intellect. The church in her pilgrimage through this world towards the Father possesses in the Holy Eucharist the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, who cannot be perceived by the senses and who has been assumed by the Sacred Humanity of Christ. In the economy of the redemption, the Eucharist was the providential means chosen by God to enable him to remain with us personally, in a unique and unrepeatable way, within each one of us.
