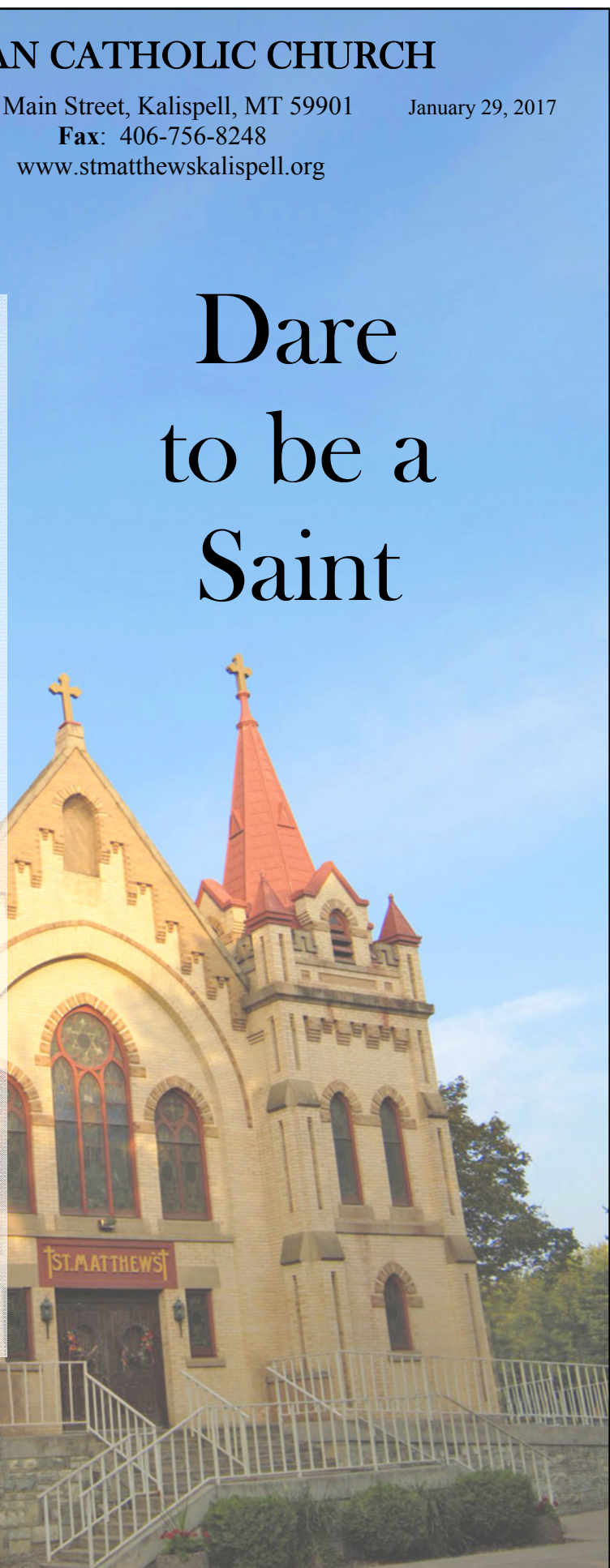

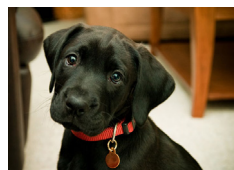

ADORATION
