

The Annunciation - The Incarnation

St. Thomas teaches that the Incarnation was the most effective and beneficial way for God to redeem mankind. He adduces the following reasons: as far as faith is concerned - it became easier to believe, since God himself was the one speaking; as far as hope - by the great proof of his salvific will that this act of revelation represents; as far as charity - since greater love than this no man has, that he lay down his life for his friends; and as far as actual deeds of love - since God himself was going to be our model.
