The Social Concerns office helped on an average of 53 people in 20 households each month. A grand total of 3,825 pounds of food and personal care items were distributed. We received 1,800 pounds of food from our generous parishioners. About 2,000 pounds of food was purchased with donated cash, scrip, and proceeds from our Fair Booth.
